

Student Support Unit

Aims

- * Implement student support work in a Whole-school Approach model to cater for students' individual differences and students with special education needs.
- * Provide appropriate guidance and support for students with different education needs.
- * Make reasonable adjustments in teaching and assessment to students with special education needs, and encourage them not to give up easily but to do their best.
- * Promote mutual respect among teachers and students, encourage home-school cooperation, and to create an inclusive environment.

Main job

- * Cooperate with different departments, institutions and professionals to understand the situation and needs of students with special education needs.
- * To plan, to implement and to review the effectiveness of various adjustment and training activities.
- * Hold case conferences for students with special education needs, to discuss supporting measures and adjustment methods with professionals, teachers and parents.
- * Promote an inclusive culture in school campus.
- * Encourage home-school cooperation and communicate with parents regularly.
- * Improve teachers' knowledge and skills in helping students with "special learning needs".

School-based support services

Speech Therapy Service

School-based speech therapists provide students with professional services such as speech assessment, speech therapy, parent consultation and workshops.

Educational Psychology Service

Provide students with educational psychological assessment, provide professional advice, promote effective teaching strategies to cater for students' special education needs, and provide comprehensive and regular case follow-up and intervention services.

Learning Support Service

Help students with special educational needs to do homework and study in groups after school.

Group training

Organize diversified learning and activity groups after school to enhance the ability of students with different education needs in different areas.

Parent support

Arrange workshops or seminars for parents to help them to improve parents' skills in caring for children with special educational needs.
